Dear Sir/Madam,

With reference to your application dated 27.10.2020 and subsequent correspondence with the school I convey the grant for provisional Renewal **Cambridge International School Palampur Tehsil Palampur District Kangra** (Name of school) for 1<sup>st</sup> to Class 8<sup>th</sup> for a period of ONE Year w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup> April 2020 to 31 March 2021. The above provisional sanction is subject to fulfillment of following conditions:-

- 1 The grant for recognition is not expendable and does not in any way imply any obligation to recognize or affiliate the school beyond Class VIII.
- 2 The school shall abide by the provision of Right of Children to free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 (Annexure I) and the Right of Children to free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011 (Annexure II).
- 3 The Society/School shall not collect any capitation fee and subject the Child or his or her parent's guardians to any screening procedure.
- 4 The School shall not deny admission to any Child,
  - 5 For lack of age proof,
  - 6 If such admission is sought subsequent to the extended period of ninety days for admission, and
  - 7 On the ground of religion, caste or race, place of birth or any of them.
  - 8 The School shall ensure that,
- 1 No Child admission shall be held back in any class or expelled from school till the completion Elementary Education in that School.
- 2 No Child shall be subjected to physical punishment or mental harassment.
- 9 No Child is required to pass any Board examination till the completion of Elementary Education.
- 10 Every Child completion Elementary Education is awarded a certificate as laid down under rules 19 of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education, Himachal Pradesh Rules, 2011.
- 11 Student with disabilities/ special needs are admission as per provision of the Act.
- 12 The Teachers are recruited with minimum qualifications as laid down under section 23(1) of the RTE Act. The current teachers who, at the commencement of this Act did not possess minimum qualifications shall acquire such minimum qualification by March, 2020.
- 13 The teacher performs his/her duties specified under section 24(1) of the Act; and
- 14 The teacher performs shall not engage himself of herself for private teaching activities.
- 15 The School shall follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum laid down by academic authority under sub-section (1) of section 29.
- 16 The School shall Enrol students proportionate to the facilities available in the school specified the section 19 of the Act.

17 The School shall maintain the standards and norms as specified in section 19 of the Act. The facilities reported at the time of last inspection are as given under ;

18 No unrecognized classes shall run within the premises of the school or outside in the name of school.

19 The school building or other structures or the ground shall not be used during the day or night for commercial or residential purpose, except for the purpose of residence of any employee of school or for political or non-education activity of any kind whatsoever.

20 The school shall be run by a society registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 (21 of 1860), or a public trust constituted under any law for the time being in force.

21 The School shall not be run for profit to any individual, group or association of individual or any other persons.

22 The accounts of the school shall be audited and certified by Chartered Accountant and proper account statement shall be prepared as per rules. A copy each of the statements of Account shall be sent to the Deputy Director/ Block Elementary Education Officer every year.

23 The Recognition code Number allotted to your school is 1751 this may please be noted and quoted for any correspondence with this office.

24 The School shall furnish such reports and information as may be required by the Director of Education/ Deputy Director/ Block Elementary Education Officer from time to time and comply with such instructions of the State Government/Local authority as may be issued to secure the continued fulfilment of the condition of recognition or the removal of deficiencies in working of the school.

25 Renewal of Registration of Society if any is ensured.

26 The State Government may specify additional conditions from time to time, for compliance.

27 If any objection found by this office you will directed to submit the objection physically (by hand) to this office within one week otherwise your recognition will be cancelled automatically.

Note: - As per direction given by the Director of Elementary Education HP Shimla Vide letter No EDN-H(Ele-IV)B(6)5-1/2013(Trg) Vol-III Dated 11 August 2017 and Letter No EDN-H-Ele(4)-4- 46/2012-17-RTE Dated 16 August 2017 you are directed to take urgent and concerted action at your end in order to ensure that all in-service un-trained teachers working in your private schools acquire the minimum qualification as prescribed by the NCTE but within the stipulated time line i.e. 31<sup>st</sup> March 2019. Failing which the services of those teachers who fail to improve their qualification before 31<sup>st</sup> March 2019 should be terminated after 1<sup>st</sup> April 2019 and such school that does not adhere to the above said directions shall be derecognized with immediate effect.
